

# Red Oil Dye

## SPRAY INDICATOR

### GENERAL INFORMATION

**Red Oil Dye** is an industrial strength red temporary spray colorant for use in monitoring spray applications. By adding **Red Oil Dye** to the spray solution, an applicator can visibly see the spray pattern and trace previously treated areas. This allows accurate placement and uniform coverage throughout the spray operation. **Red Oil Dye** indicates drift and improves application which helps to reduce waste from spraying unwanted areas. **Red Oil Dye** may be used in industrial and forestry applications with any type of spray equipment, either hand held, back pack, or broadcast.

#### Active Ingredients:

Red Dye and Coupling Agents . . . . . 100 %

All ingredients exempt from tolerance requirements under CFR 40, 180.1001.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

The recommended concentration of **Red Oil Dye** may be adjusted for specific operations. Higher dosage rates will increase the darkness of the spray pattern.

#### CAUTION - Keep out of reach of children.

Prolonged contact may cause skin or eye irritation. Wear personal protective equipment when handling. Follow the use directions and precautions on the label of the pesticide you are using. Do not wear contact lenses when using chemicals. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after using and before eating, drinking, or smoking.

#### FIRST AID

**If on skin or clothing:** Wash affected area with soap and water. Remove clothing drenched with concentrate as soon as practical and launder separately. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

**In case of eye contact:** Flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

**If swallowed:** Drink 1-2 glasses of water or milk to dilute. Contact a physician.
